INPUTS	ACTIVITIES <small>The things you “do” with your inputs – the actions</small>	OUTPUTS <small>Product or service stemming from a completed group of activities</small>	IMMEDIATE OUTCOMES <small>Short-term results emerging from the outputs that often represent a change in knowledge or skill</small>	INTERMEDIATE OUTCOMES <small>Medium-term results emerging from immediate outcomes that usually represent a change in behavior or practice</small>	ULTIMATE OUTCOME <small>Longer-term results emerging from the intermediate outcomes that the project is working towards</small>

¹ This example is based on a food aid program for displaced people living in camps after conflict forced them to flee their homes. The unit of measurement for this project will be households.
